

OFFSHORE MOZAMBIQUE FIELD DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Eni East Africa S.p.A., a company incorporated under the laws of Italy with a branch in the Republic of Mozambique (hereinafter referred to as "**Eni East Africa**"), Operator of offshore Area 4 located in the Rovuma Block in the Republic of Mozambique, is evaluating, as part of the development strategy for Area 4, the execution of Supply of Umbilicals subject to the receipt of all necessary approvals and authorizations from all relevant parties and authorities.

Eni East Africa invites interested local and international companies, hereinafter referred to as "Candidates", to participate in the **Expression of Interest** for the following potential Tender:

Scope of Work

Supply of Umbilicals and ancillary equipment for Mamba Development Project.

This is not an invitation to participate in the above-mentioned potential Tender but only an invitation to participate to the Expression of Interest. If you wish to participate, please address your letter of interest duly signed by the authorized person (together with notarized powers of attorney or other evidence of authority of such authorized person, satisfactory to eni East Africa) and submit the following mandatory information and documentation by registering on our website indicated below:

- 1) Evidence of proven experience in engineering, design and production of the Electro-Hydraulic Umbilical and ancillary equipment for long tie-back from shore to the subsea structures stating the number of projects in the last ten years, indicating for each project the quantity of umbilicals supplied (in km) and water depth for:
 - i. main umbilical section
 - ii. infield umbilical section
- 2) In case you wish to participate in the Expression of Interest as a consortium or as a joint venture, provide information about each member of consortium or joint venture and role and participation interest of each participant in the potential project. Such intention to form either a Consortium or a JV, must be supported by an Agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each entity in the group.

The Expression of Interest Questionnaire will be provided only to interested Candidates that comply with the above requirements.
