

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST CUSTOM CLEARANCE SERVICES FOR ENI EAST AFRICA S.p.A. ACTIVITIES IN THE REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE

Eni East Africa S.p.A. invites interested companies to submit expressions of interest for Custom Clearance and Shipping Services to be carried out for eni east africa's activities in the Republic of Mozambique.

Scope of the work is performing full Customs clearance services, on a "non-exclusive" basis, for all Permanent and Temporary Importation/exportation shipments arriving and departing from/to Mozambique by marine/air/road/rail transportation.

The scope includes full Shipping services, on a "non-exclusive" basis.

Companies interested to this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* to participate in a tender process for "Custom Clearance" by registering on our website indicated below and submitting the following required documentation:

- 1. Company and group structure with the list of major shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange);
- 2. Scanned certified copy of the trade register in Mozambique, legal entity name and contact person for receiving qualification and commercial information;
- 3. Evidence of consolidated experience of at least 2 years in Africa, for Customs and Shipping services in Oil & Gas business;
- 4. Quality Management System Manual or Certificate in compliance with international Quality Standards (ISO 9001:2008);
- 5. Financial balance sheets (last year)/Annual Report proving minimum financial capacity for the realization of the scope of work.

Within the website application, under the section "Type of Application" select: Recommendation or invitation received by eni and in the area "Origin of the invitation" specify as follows: "Custom Clearance".

Only companies or consortium or JV which have been submitted all requested documentation and which are positively evaluated (compliant with all minimum requirements listed in the bullet point from 1 to 5 above), will be considered for potential tenders for the scope of service described above.

Subject to the positive evaluation of the submitted documentation, applicants may receive from Eni East Africa the Qualification Package.

The purpose of the information and documents request is to start a "qualification process" and to give an opportunity to the selected companies to provide details of their legal structure, management, experience, resources and overall capability to perform the service.

This request for expression of interest shall not be considered an invitation to bid and therefore it does not represent or constitute any promise, obligation or commitment of any kind on the part of Eni East Africa, to enter into any agreement or arrangement with you or with any company participating in this pre-enquiry.
