



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

TPM Marine Services in the republic of Mozambique

Eni East Africa S.p.A. invites interested companies to submit expressions of interest for the provision of services consisting of Towing, Piloting, Mooring and Marine Maintenance (TPM) services for the berthing and un-berthing operations of Liquefied Natural Gas Carriers, Condensate Export Carriers and other vessels to the Floating LNG unit (FLNG) position, that will be located in the Area 4 of Rovuma Basin, approximately at 135 nautical miles offshore from the north east coast of Pemba, Moçambique.

Companies interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* by providing the following required documentation:

1. Letter of interest duly signed by the authorized person (together with notarized powers of attorney or other evidence of authority of such authorized person)
2. Evidence of having across the last five years, at least two evincible experiences in providing Offshore Marine Services for LNG marine terminal, FLNG, FPSO or similar projects which shall include :
 - a. Tugs' ownership and/or provision of tug services using , ASD type tugs, having a bollard pull (continuous static pull) of about 80-120 Tons;
 - b. Pilot and/or Mooring Master with proved experience in side by side and tandem moorings;
 - c. Pilot transfer, Hose Handling and Mooring Assistance during berthing and un-berthing operations at sea using a multipurpose boats;
3. Company and Group Structure with the list of major Shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in any stock exchange);
4. Scanned Certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification and commercial information;
5. Filled Qualification Form of the Requirements for the Technical Pre-Qualification of Offshore Vessels Owners (available here: https://eprocurement.eni.it/int_eng/content/view/full/253084);
6. Document of Compliance (DOC) issued under SOLAS 74/78 Chapt.IX, Reg.4 for the type of Tug to be managed;
7. Quality Management System certifications and/or certificates proving the Company compliance with national or international Quality Standards (e.g. ISO 9001:2008);
8. Health & Safety Management System certification and/or documents proving the company compliance with international standards(ISO18001);
9. Financial statements and balance sheets or Annual Reports of last 3 years, proving minimum financial capacity for the realization of the scope of work.

10. In case you wish to participate in the Expression of Interest as a consortium or as a joint venture, information about each member of consortium or joint venture and role of each participant in the potential project. Such intention to form either a consortium or a JV, must be supported by an Agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each entity in the group.
