



**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST  
FOR MONITORING OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN IN THE REPUBLIC OF  
MOZAMBIQUE**

**Eni East Africa S.p.A. ("EEA")** invites interested companies to submit the *Expressions of Interest* for monitoring of environmental and management plan for Eni East Africa S.p.A.

**SCOPE OF WORK:**

1. Conduct environmental audits in accordance with applicable legal requirements and international best practices;
2. Monitoring and control of the implementation of Environmental Management Plans and specific Environmental Management Programs (including field and cabinet activities);
3. Allocation of human resources to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Environmental Management Plans (Environmental Control Officers and Officials of Environmental Control and Communication);
4. Conducting environmental training and environmental awareness campaigns;
5. Conduct public participation processes during the project implementation phase;
6. Preparation of Progress Reports and Environmental Performance Reports for the Company and stakeholders (authorities and other interested and affected parties);
7. Updating of Environmental Management Plans;
8. Elaboration of addenda to Environmental Impact Study Reports;
9. Elaboration and revision of Declarations of Environmental Method.

**CANDIDATES:**

Companies interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* duly signed by the authorized person (together with certified Powers of attorney or other evidence of authority of such authorized person) along with the following mandatory information and documentation providing evidence of:

1. Scanned and certified copy of the trade register, legal entity name and contact person for receiving qualification and commercial information;
2. Last three years of Financial Statements including Balance Sheets;

3. Company and group structure with the list of major shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries;
4. Documented evidence of at least 10 years of experience in conducting Environmental Impact Assessment processes in Mozambique;
5. Documented evidence of at least 5 years of experience in conducting environmental audits for environmental authority and other purposes;
6. Documented evidence of at least 5 years of experience in the implementation of Environmental Management Plans;
7. Documented evidence of EIA experience for oil and gas (Offshore and Onshore) activities and specialized studies;
8. Copy of the valid permits of the consultant of the EIA and environmental Auditor issued by the environmental authority; the company must be provided;
9. Having Quality Management System certifications and/or Quality Management System compliant with international Quality Standards (ISO 9001:2008);
10. Having Environmental Management System certification compliant with international Quality Standards (ISO 14001:2015).
