



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES FOR ENI EAST AFRICA SPA ACTIVITIES IN THE REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE

Eni East Africa S.p.A. (EEA) invites companies interested to submit their expressions of interest to perform *Environmental Initiatives* to be carried out for EEA's operations in the Republic of Mozambique.

Scope of the work includes mainly the following:

- Implement anti-litter campaigns e.g. cleanup events;
- Execute recycling workshops and presentations at schools;
- Undertake environmental education and awareness campaigns e.g. food gardening and tree planting workshops;
- Conduct guided tours in places of environmental interest e.g. botanical gardens.

3. Last three years financial statements/Annual Report proving minimum financial capacity for the realization of the scope of work;
4. Company and group structure with the list of major shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange);
5. Documented proof of 5 years' experience in conducting environmental sustainable activities aimed at promoting environmental awareness and encourage people's participation for preservation and conservation of environment;
6. General information about the Company profile;
7. Having Quality Management System certifications and/or Quality Management

- System compliant with international Quality Standards (e.g. ISO 9001:2008);
8. Company shall demonstrate experience in conducting at least three projects related to environmental sustainability in Mozambique related to waste recycling, biodiversity conservation and active citizenship development;
 9. Evidence proving that Company has experience in conducting environmental educational campaigns;
 10. List of available professional staff to conduct environmental activities for operations onshore and offshore. Key qualification and information about subcontracted staff/services shall be provided;
